In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen G2 (G1)
- 52. Say the Hail Mary**
Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with thee. Blessed art thou among women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus. Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death. Amen G2 (G1)
- 53. Say the Our Father**
Our Father, Who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name; Thy kingdom come; Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen G2 (G1)
- 54. Say the Angel of God Prayer**
Angel of God, my guardian dear, to whom God's love commits me here. Ever this day be at my side to light and guard, to rule and guide. Amen G2 (G1)
- 55. Say Grace Before Meals**
Bless us, O Lord, and these Thy gifts, which we are about to receive from Thy bounty through Christ Our Lord. Amen G2 (G1)

56. Say Grace After Meals

*We give You thanks, Almighty God for all Your benefits who lives and reigns now and forever. Amen
G2 (G1)*

57. Say the Glory Be

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, as it was in the beginning is now and ever shall be, world without end. Amen G2 (G1)

58. Act of Contrition

Oh my God, I am heartily sorry for having offended You and I detest all my sins because of Your just punishments, but most of all because they offend You, my God, who are all good and deserving of all my love. I firmly resolve, with the help of Your grace, to sin no more and to avoid the near occasion of sin. Amen G2)

59. Say the Morning Offering

O Jesus, through the Immaculate Heart of Mary, I offer You all my prayers, works, joys and sufferings of this day, in union with the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass throughout the world. I offer them for all the intentions of Your Sacred Heart, the salvation of souls, reparation for sin, the reunion of all Christians. I offer them for all the intentions of our bishops and of all the Apostles of Prayer, and in particular, for those recommended by our Holy Father for this month. Amen G2
