By virtue of their baptismal call, members of St. John the Evangelist Parish are responsible for spiritual and physical growth of the parish through Witness and faithful service. **Attendance at Mass is an important sign not only of our common faith, but also of our support for each member of our faith community.** Mass attendance is tracked through the envelope system. It is important for you to place an envelope, regardless of the contents, into the collection basket each week. The amount of your contribution is confidential – not even the pastor is given this information.

Parents of school-age children must recognize that they are the primary educators of their children in the practice of the faith and that they must fulfill the obligation to provide for the continuing religious education of their children.

All members of the parish are encouraged to be active in some aspect of parish life. The extent of this participation is left up to each individual's personal choice, schedule, individual talents and life status. Participation in any of the ministries is open to everyone with the exception of Lector and Eucharist Minister, in which case you must be free to receive the Eucharist by the norms of Church law – for example, marriage outside of the Church would preclude this possibility.

I understand the reasons for this policy and I promise to attend Sunday Eucharist at St. John the Evangelist on a regular basis and agree to do whatever I can to participate in parish life.
