## Code of Conduct

1. Participants are expected to partake in assigned activities and wear their name tags during all program activities.
2. Dress during the retreat is casual. Jeans, t-shirts, etc., are fine. Clothing with offensive or obscene words, pictures, symbols, etc. are not acceptable. Shirts and shoes must be worn at all sessions and meals. No halter tops, tank tops or sleeveless shirts are allowed. Shorts length must be appropriate (when a person is standing straight with arms hanging to side, shorts must meet or pass their fingertips). Pants must not sag, or a belt will be provided. Some of the session will be held outside, so please plan according to the weather.
3. Language & conduct should reflect the values we proclaim as Catholics & Christians.
4. Participants are to remain with their group at all times during the retreat unless accompanied by adult chaperones.
5. Each day will be long and busy! Make sure you get adequate sleep!
6. Smoking and the use of tobacco products is not allowed by any participants during the retreat. Violation of this rule will result in immediate dismissal from the retreat. The possession or use of alcohol, illegal drugs or weapons will not be tolerated. Breaking this rule will mean immediate dismissal from the retreat. (Parents will be called, regardless of the hour).
7. No food or drinks are allowed in the Chapel area of our retreat. All food and drink must stay in the designated areas.
8. Respect and reverence for all is expected! Please show the reverence and honor that is due to God and respect those around you by treating all as you want to be treated.
